

**MEMORANDUM FOR EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS
BETWEEN
RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY RATTANAKOSIN
AND
NAGAOKA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY**

In accordance with clause 1-(2) of the Agreement of Academic and Educational Collaboration between Rajamangala University of Technology Rattanakosin (RMUTR) and Nagaoka University of Technology (NUT), the two universities hereby agree to promote exchange of students.

1. Period of Stay

The maximum period of stay for exchange students in the host university shall be one academic year or the equivalent; extension of this period shall require approval from both universities.

2. Number of Exchange Students

Each university shall send and accept under this Memorandum not more than five students per academic year. The number of students shall be fixed by annual consultation between the two universities.

3. Selection of Exchange Students

Each university shall be responsible for the nomination of qualified candidates for the exchange program. Each university will select its own exchange students giving particular consideration to the language of the host university.

4. Status of Exchange Students

Exchange students already enrolled in undergraduate/post-graduate study at Rajamangala University of Technology Rattanakosin or Nagaoka University of Technology shall be admitted as special or exchange students (non-degree students) in the respective host university for the period of exchange.

5. Field of Study for Exchange Students

The field of study for exchange students must be one for which the host university can appoint a qualified supervisor for the students.

6. Study Program and Evaluation

The study program at the host university will be determined for exchange students in consultation with the academic advisers of both the host and home universities. Academic performance shall be evaluated according to the rules of the host university.

7. Academic Record and Accreditation

Each host university agrees to provide to the home university the academic record obtained by exchange students, which will be accredited according to the rules of the home university.

8. Tuition

Exchange students shall pay normal tuition to the home university, and there shall be no requirement for payment of tuition, screening fees, or admission fees to the host university. Neither university will impose additional fees for tuition or academic services.

9. Accommodation

The host university shall make its best efforts to assist exchange students in finding accommodation at a reasonable cost.

10. Financial Responsibility

The Exchange students shall be responsible for their own expenses including travel expenses, living expenses, accommodation costs, medical expenses, and personal expenses such as telephone charges, books, etc. The exchange students shall be required to purchase health and casualty insurance at the minimum level of coverage recommended by the host university to cover such contingencies while in the host university and such premiums shall be borne by the exchange students.

11. Discipline

The exchange students shall receive the full rights of students in the host university and be bound by the rules and regulations of the host university.

12. Intellectual Property

It is understood that the title to all inventions or discoveries made solely by RMUTR resulting from the research performed hereunder shall reside in RMUTR, title to all inventions or discoveries made solely by NUT shall reside in NUT, and title to all inventions and discoveries made jointly by NUT and RMUTR shall reside jointly in NUT and RMUTR.

13. Other


Other matters necessary for the exchange students shall be mutually determined as specific cases require.
