Its mission is to promote exchange and cooperation between Chinese and other countries' education systems, adhering to the principle of introducing high-quality international educational resources and promoting the integration of Chinese and global education. CCIEE aims to build bridges for international educational exchange and cooperation between Chinese and foreign universities, promote the internationalization of higher education institutions, and cultivate high-quality, internationally-minded talents.

After more than 20 years of development, China Education International, through the recommendation of Chinese embassies and consulates abroad and exchange associations, has established close cooperative relationships with more than 200 overseas universities and educational institutions in more than 20 countries, including the United States, the United Kingdom, Canada, Finland, New Zealand, and South Korea. It has built a platform for international cooperation and exchange for more than 400 domestic universities, forming a business scope centered on serving the internationalization of universities. This includes long-term and short-term overseas study tours for university students, dual degree programs with mutual recognition of credits between China and foreign countries and degree upgrading programs, international capacity building programs for university teachers to study abroad and doctoral level training, Sino-foreign cooperative education programs and programs for coming to China, as well as holding large-scale international conferences and professional forums.
