

# Les Campus d'Excellence design – métiers d'art et mode de la région académique Paris Ile de France, French Republic

Les Campus d'Excellence design – métiers d'art et mode de la région académique Paris Ile de France is an organization established under the Paris Educational Area and the Île-de-France region, under the supervision of the head of the educational area, who chairs the meeting of rectors of all universities and higher education institutions within that educational area. Campus d'Excellence is a French government educational management concept aimed at developing excellent personnel. In areas considered national strategies (in this case, the design of art and fashion professions), by integrating the potential of vocational education institutions that excel in design, art and fashion professions, universities, cultural institutions, and professional federations, with serious support from both the government and leading private sector entities involved.

Les Campus d'Excellence design – métiers d'art et mode de la région académique Paris Ile de France currently comprises two vocational excellence institutions: [The Paris Network of Vocational Excellence in Arts and Design at the Gobelins Manufactory](#) and [the Network of Vocational Excellence Institutes in the Arts Professions of Versailles: Heritage and Crafts of Excellence](#), which have overlapping, distinct, and complementary areas of expertise. In the future, this will include the network of vocational excellence institutions in Creteil, which is home to the Chanel brand's M19 institute, an institution that brings together a wealth of French ancient arts and fashion professional expertise.

The Network of Vocational Excellence in Arts and Design Institutions in Paris at the Gobelins Manufactory focuses on expertise in interior architecture, stone art, fire art, ceramics, glass engraving, stained glass, metal art, product design, jewelry, hat and watch design, exhibition and stage design, graphic design, and paper art. Digital printing and design, textile arts, leather goods, and other fashion disciplines are taught at 27 vocational art and design institutions and 2 universities: L'ENS Paris-Saclay and HESAM Université. Numerous cultural institutions serve as patrons, and 3 leading private companies, including Comité Colbert, Hermès, and Institut des Métiers d'Excellence – LVMH, are patrons.

Network of Vocational Excellence Institutes in the Arts Professions of Versailles: Heritage and Crafts of Excellence, specializing in cultural construction and architectural design, arts and design professions, gardening and landscaping, culinary arts, and tourism. Culturally, it includes 82 educational institutions related to various areas of expertise, 5 universities and higher education institutions: CY Cergy Paris Université, UVSQ Université Versailles-Saint-Quentin, l'École Nationale Supérieure d'Architecture de Versailles (ENSA-V), l'École nationale supérieure de paysage (ENSP), and l'Institut Supérieur International du Parfum, de la Cosmétique et de l'Aromatique alimentaire (ISIPCA). It is sponsored by private companies and professional associations, including the Groupement des entreprises de restauration des monuments historiques, the Association nationale des entreprises du Patrimoine Vivant, the Académie Nationale de la Cuisine, the Compagnons des Devoirs Unis, the Fibois forestry network, the Bettencourt Foundation, the Engie Foundation, and the Hermès Foundation.
